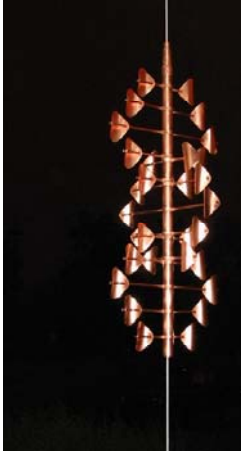

Each sculpture design creates a different motion when turning and the sculptures rotate silently in the slightest breeze. The gallery is also home to two smaller designs featured on the front porch of the gallery. Penny's custom sculptures are featured nationally in residential and commercial locations. Penny works from his company, AeroKinetic Studios, in Holly Springs, NC. His work is made to the client's specifications and finish choices in natural, clear coat and weathered patina are available for a variety of designs.
